Transit's Role in TDM


- Transit is just a piece of the puzzle



- Allows users to get real time information about the location of their bus
- Instant Updates
 - Provides text or email alerts about specific routes
- Trip Planner



- Provides timing, routing and connection information
- Integration with other mobility options and new employer tools





Make it Easier

- NFTA Metro's Fare Collection Project
 - Account based system
 - Allows for stored value and passes
 - Automatic reloading (tied to bank account or credit card)
 - Will provide one-day best value
 - Turnstiles added to stations
 - Loss protection
 - Mobile ticketing options
- Phase 1 roll out anticipated in fall of 2017







Be Good Partners

- Metro Perk Provides
 Advantages for NFTA, business
 and employees
 - Pre-tax benefit
 - Convenient: Deducted from payroll
 - Reduced taxable income for the employee
- Only part of the solution







Conclusion

- Good transit is good for business
